



Be Prepared for a Loss

Are you able to substantiate what you owned or how much it was worth after a total loss? Unfortunately, many people are not prepared for a loss. Follow these steps to be prepared after a fire, burglary or other mishap.

1. Complete an inventory of the contents of your home.
2. Have complete appraisals made of items of significant value like jewelry, furs, silverware, art, etc.
3. Record the make, model, serial number of the high value items such as tvs, stereos, cameras, appliances etc.
4. Take photos or a video of the contents of your home and make sure they are dated when recorded.
5. Keep all receipts and cheques as a record of your purchase.
6. Keep all of your documentation in a safe place away from your home in case of a total loss or burglary.
